The singing was not about a physical family but a different group, the family of God. It too is mark by love and acceptance, but there is one major difference when comparing the families. You do not choose your physical family, whereas choice is the only way to become a part of God's family. No one can choose their earthly family. You didn't say, "I'll take The Wit & Wisdumb

No, it's through God's providence that you become part of a family. Conversely, you have to make a conscious choice to enter God's family. 


